(No it's not true that his wife wanted more room in the garage.)

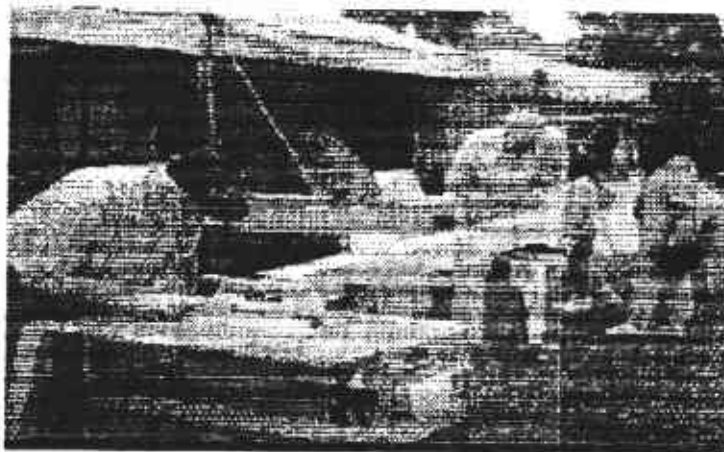
Members note.....
