SHOP SKILLS

FOLDING BANDSAW BLADES

SIMPLE AS

ONE, TWO, THREE



Our readers have shown us several ways of folding bandsaw blades. Here's how one of them, Werner Zinn of Orlando, Florida, described it:

Hold the blade in front of you with one hand, keeping the teeth pointing away from you. Wear a glove if you've got one handy. Put your foot inside the loop and step on the blade, securing it firmly to the floor. Simultaneously rotate and lower your hand as you hold the top of the blade. By the time your hand makes $\frac{3}{4}$ to one full revolution, the blade will have popped into three coils. ♣
