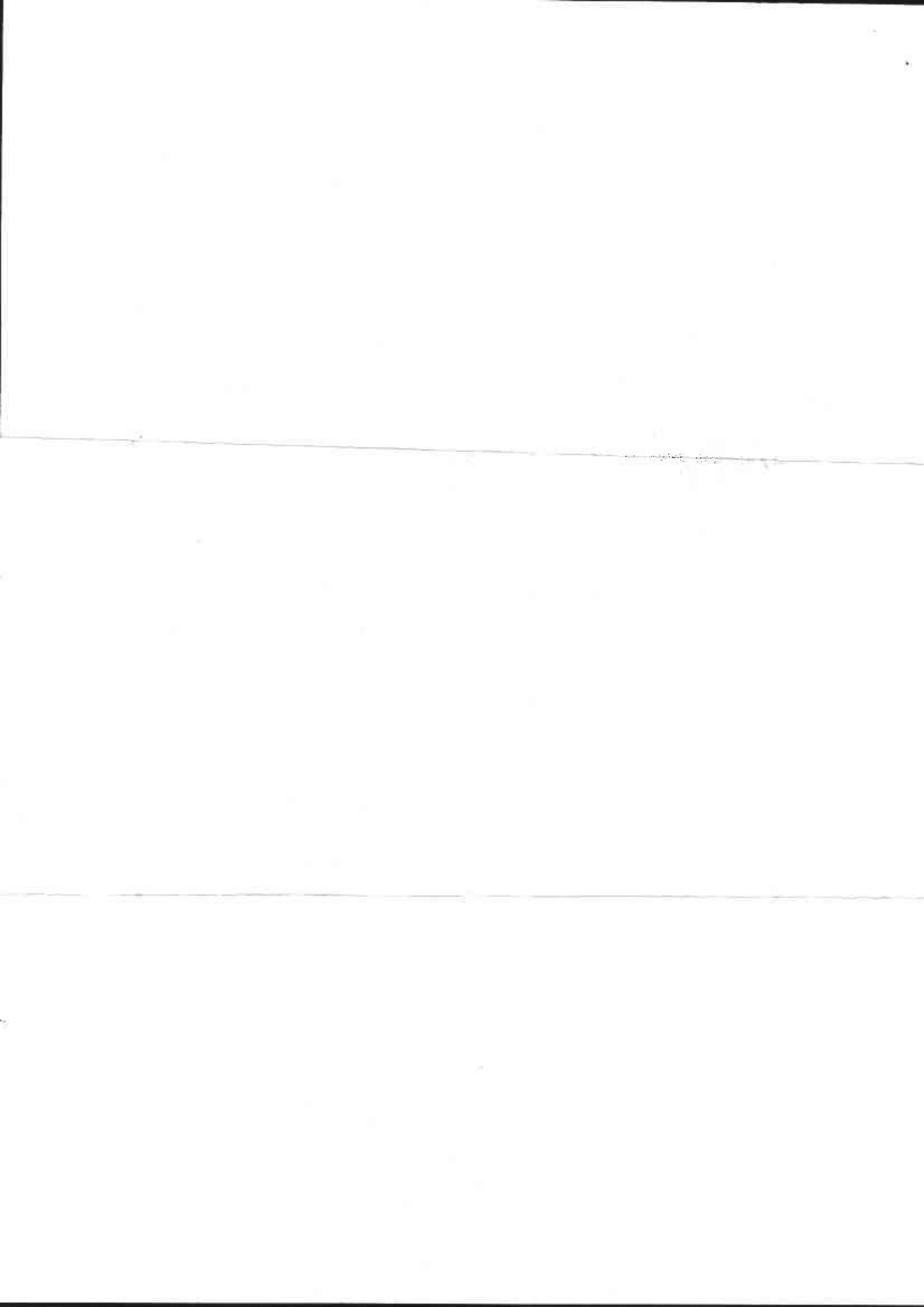
Once again Christmas is almost upon us. Our Christmas break-up is on Saturday, 9th of December at 6 pm. I hope to see you there.
