Dear Resident,

After nearly 6 months of research, lobbying and arranging expressions of interest, involving over 80 local businesses located in the South-East annex of William Angliss Estate, Laverton, we are pleased to advise that increased local cabling has been installed adjacent to the corner of Norwest Avenue and William Angliss Drive.

Resident business owners in **Norwest Avenue, Oban Court and Weddel Court** have been anxiously awaiting the arrival of suitable cabling to permit them to contract ADSL services with us.

As a joint initiative, **Alchester Business Systems** in conjunction with local Real Estate Agents: **Raine and Horne**, undertook a detailed review of the needs of local residents, and looked at all available technologies in the area for servicing internet connections – starting back in November 2005.

What emerged, was a realisation that copper cable length was too long between residents and the nearest DSL equipped exchange in Cherry St Laverton due to the direction that the original cables travelled (via Boundary Rd). Alchester embarked on exploring alternative solutions and identifying the exact nature of the problem for local businesses in the area. This involved dealing with the developers, providing open information to property owners, tenants, infrastructure managers of the estate, and a range of ISP's and service providers in the industry.

Solution: Run copper cable in a more direct route between the new estate area and the local exchange.

With the feedback thru "Expressions Of Interest" and making appropriate departments acutely aware of the needs of the estate, Telstra works were recently undertaken to lay the needed cables down the southern stretch:
