

9 REGISTER OF MEMBERS

The Secretary shall keep and maintain a register of members in which shall be entered the full name and address and telephone number of each member and a copy of the register may be prominently displayed at the Club premises.

10 EXPULSION OR DISCIPLINING OF MEMBER

Any member deemed by the Committee to have been guilty of conduct prejudicial to the interests of the Club may be summoned by the Committee to a General Meeting convened especially for the purpose of considering the alleged offence. If the general meeting deems appropriate it may either suspend the member for a period of up to 12 months or expel that member from the club. There would be no right of appeal.

11 OFFICERS OF THE CLUB

The officers of the Club shall be:

- (a) The Permanent Public Officer; and
- (b) The President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and Newsletter Editor, who shall be Members qualifying under Rule 4 to hold such positions.
They will hold office for ONE year, after which time they may, if they so wish, offer themselves for re-election.

12 THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

- (1) The affairs of the Club shall be managed by a Committee composed of up to 10 members of the Club, which shall include the Officers of the Club, but not necessarily the Public Officer. Any 5 members of the committee constitute a quorum for the conduct of the business of a meeting of the club. No business may be conducted unless a quorum is present.
- (2) The Committee shall have the power to appoint, for any special purpose, a Sub-committee.
- (3) The Committee shall have the power to make By-Laws, which shall have effect until rescinded by the Committee or the Members at a General Meeting.
- (4) In the event of a casual vacancy in any office referred to in sub-clause (1), the Committee may appoint a financial member to the vacant office and the member so appointed may continue in office up to and including the conclusion of the Annual General Meeting following the date of his appointment.

13 ELECTION OF OFFICERS AND VACANCY

Written nomination of candidates for election as Specific Officers of the Club shall be: -

- (a) Delivered to the Secretary of the Club at least SEVEN days prior to the date fixed for Annual General Meeting:
or
- (b) If no written nominations are received at least SEVEN days prior to the date fixed for Annual General Meeting, nominations may be received during the course of the election proceedings at the Annual General Meeting.
