- (c) At least $\frac{3}{4}$ majority votes of members are required to pass any resolution.

26 SEAL

- (a) The Common Seal of the Club shall be kept in the custody of the Secretary.
- (b) The Common Seal shall not be affixed to any instrument except by authority of the Committee and the affixing of the Common Seal shall be attested by the signatures either of two members of the Committee or of one member of the Committee and the Public Officer of the Club.

27 CLUB FUNDS

All moneys belonging to the Club shall be paid by the Treasurer into a separate account in the name of the Club, at a bank nominated by the Committee. All cheques shall be signed by any TWO of THREE nominated Committee Members. The Committee shall have power to invest funds.

The funds of the Club shall be derived from:

- (a) Donations
- (b) Joining Fees and Annual Subscriptions of Members
- (c) Officially organised fund raising activities

28 FINANCIAL YEAR AND AUDIT

The Club's Financial Year shall end on 31st August each year. All Funds shall be audited yearly by an accountant or other qualified person.

A duly audited and signed Balance Sheet and Accounts shall be submitted at each Annual General Meeting (Auditor to be approved by the Executive Committee).

29 DISSOLUTION

If, at an Annual General Meeting, a resolution for the dissolution of the Club shall have been duly proposed and passed in accordance with Rule 16, so much of the assets of the Club shall be realised as may be required to discharge all liabilities and any remaining assets shall be donated to the Knox City Council.

30 CUSTODY OF RECORDS

- (a) Except as otherwise provided in these rules, the Secretary shall keep in his custody or under his control all books, documents and securities of the Club.
- (b) The accounts and books referred to in sub-clause (a) shall be available for inspection by members.
